- * Decorating - Open to members or guests! Share this with a friend! Set-up and/or put away.

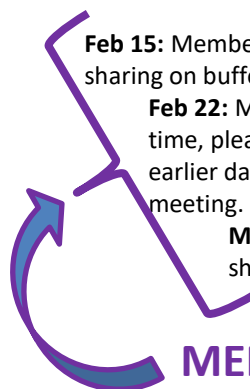
